

How to pick the right Molinari® Glove for you.

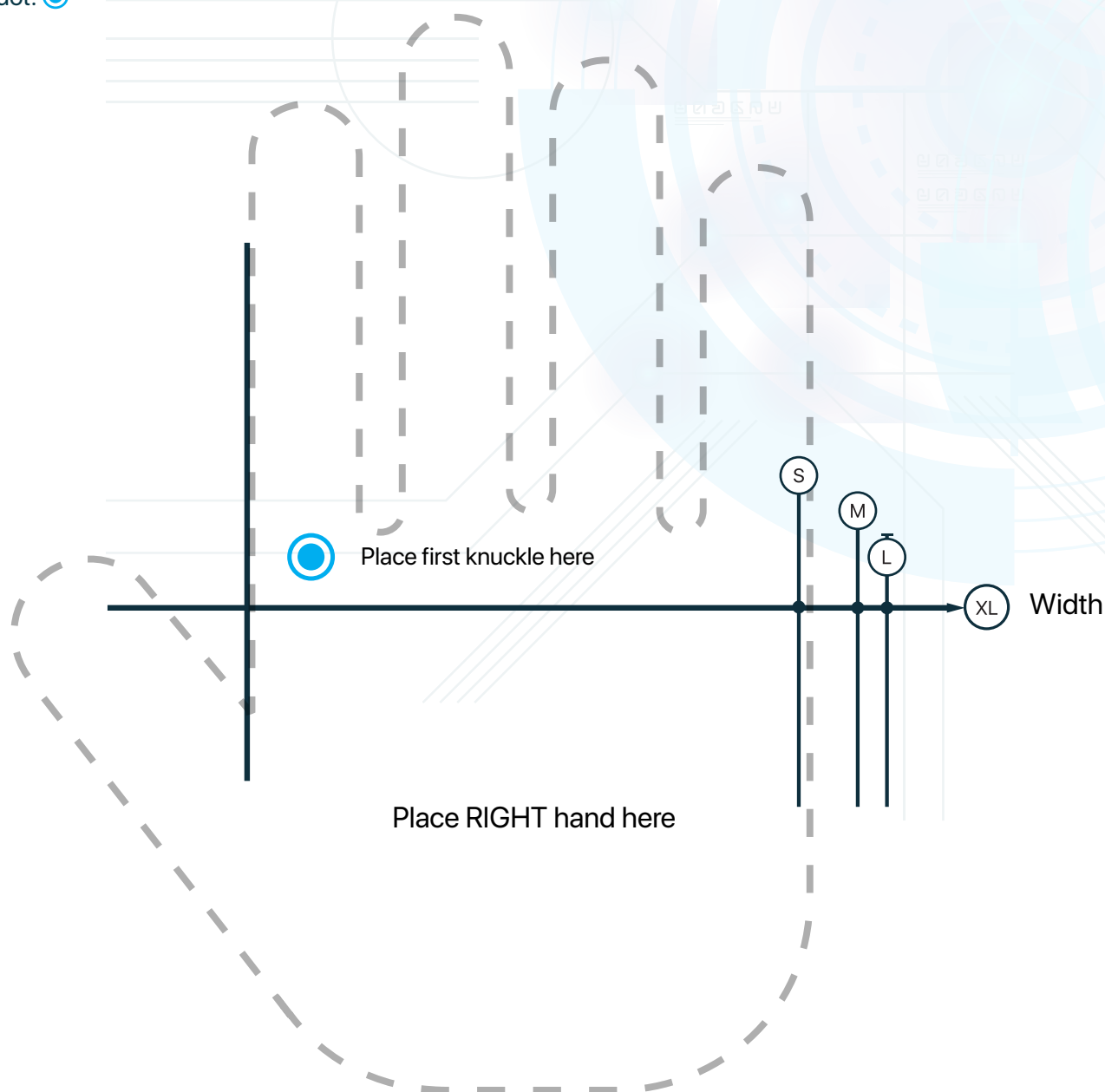
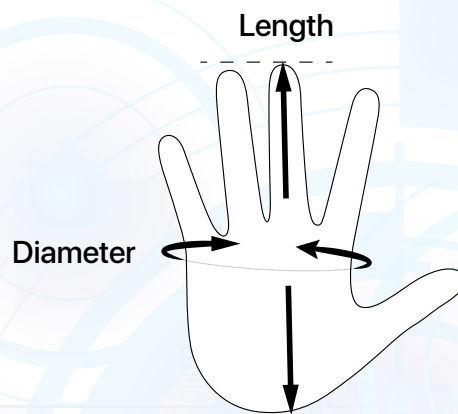
A properly fitted glove is important. The glove is the direct point of contact with your cue and if it doesn't fit quite right, it might affect your play. A correct fit for your cue glove is an advantage to your biljart game that should not be overlooked. Follow the steps beneath to find the perfect fitted glove for you. We provided 2 options for you where you can determine the correct glove size.

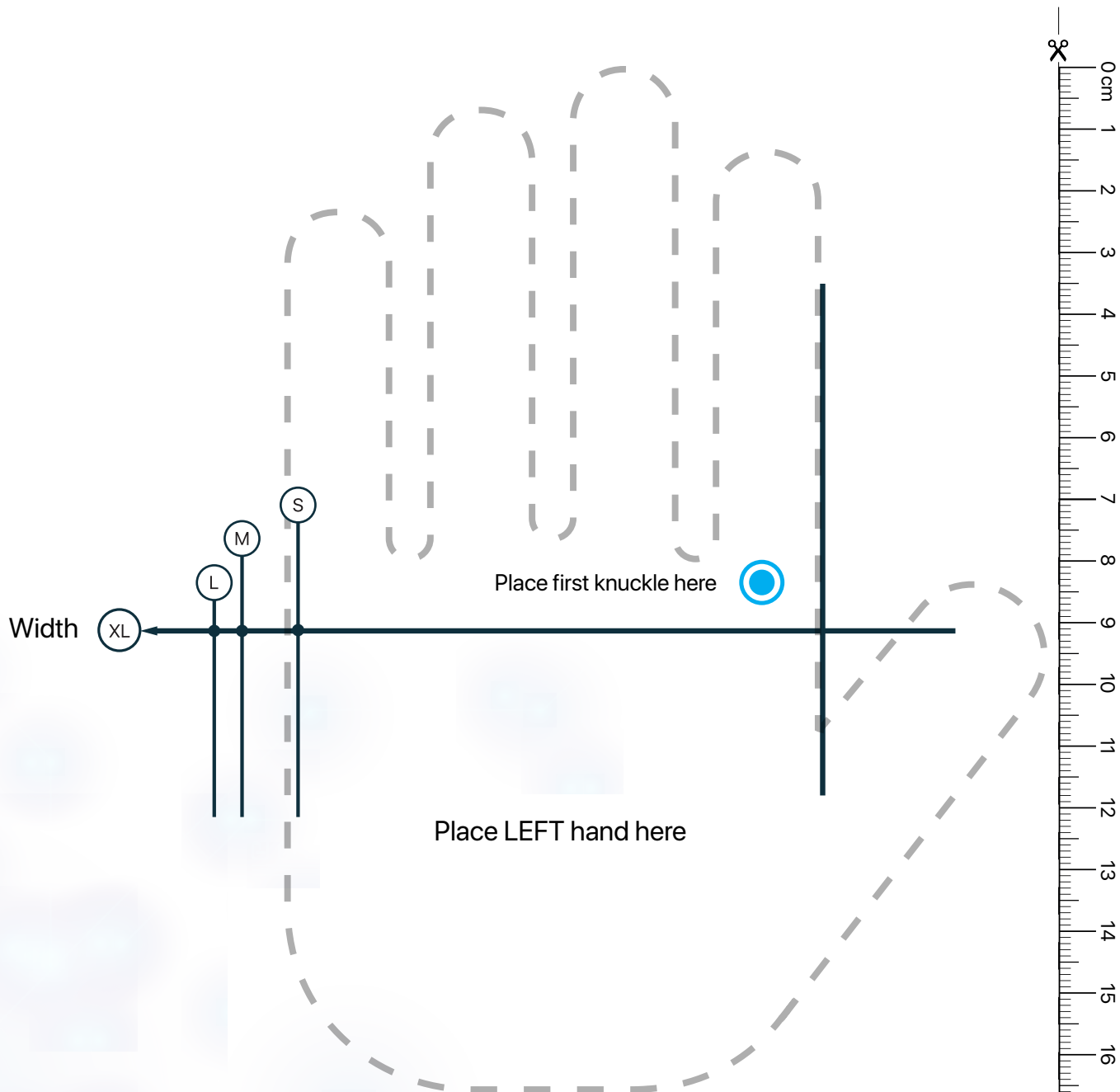
Step 1: Measurements

Option 1: To measure the diameter of your hand. Wrap a tape measure tight around the widest part of your palm, just below the knuckles, ensuring your thumb remains outside. Do this the same for the length of your hand by measuring the top of your middle finger to the bottom of your palm.

TIP: Don't have a tape measure? use the provided tape measure on page 2 by cutting it out.

Option 2: You can also place your hand on the image below. Make sure the position of your first knuckle of your index fingers aligns with the dot. ●





Step 2: Determine your size

Use the measurement to determine your size with the conversion table. If your measurement falls between two sizes, opt for the smaller one, as the material will gradually conform to your hand and may stretch slightly over time.

Size	Length (cm)	Diameter (cm)	Width (cm)
S	17 - 18	17 - 19	7,4 - 8,3
M	18 - 19	19 - 21	8,3 - 9,2
L	19 - 20	21 - 23	9,2 - 10
XL	21+	23+	10+
